Hinesville begins road resurfacing project

Hinesville, GA — The City of Hinesville has begun the 2015 Resurfacing Project for city roads. Resurfacing began May 20 and will continue through June 30. Restriping will be complete by July 30. The following roads will be resurfaced in the order listed: Quail Trail; Hemingway, Strickland and West streets; Fraser Drive; Patton Road; Eisenhower Drive; Carter and Pineview streets; Ashmore Road; Thrasher Court; Whipporwill Way; Mocking Bird Court; Citation Boulevard; Meadow Lake Drive and Sequoia Circle.

Once the asphalt surface has reached the end of its service life on roads, they are considered for resurfacing. The Hinesville Public Works department uses rating criteria that evaluates roadway failures, cracking and overall condition. A high score indicates worse conditions than a low score. Streets are ranked from highest to lowest and the worst roads are addressed first. The new surface will improve driving conditions and protect the structural integrity of the roadway.

The road work is funded 70 percent by a Georgia Department of Transportation Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant provided to the City of Hinesville annually by the state of Georgia. The LMIG program is designed to help improve local streets quickly. The city of Hinesville was required to provide a 30 percent match from general fund revenues.
