Election of New Mayor Pro Tem at June 6 Council Meeting

HINESVILLE, Ga. (June 5, 2019) – During the June 6 meeting, the Hinesville City Council voted to name District 2 Councilman Jason Floyd Mayor Pro Tem with a unanimous vote.

The Mayor Pro Tem will assume the duties of the mayor in the event of the mayor's absence or inability to perform the duties of the office. The position of Mayor Pro Tem has been vacant since the resignation of former District 5 Councilman Kenneth Shaw. With the March election of Councilman Karl Riles, the council was able to vote to fill the position again.

This appointment will expire at the end of the present four – year term for City Council, which will be end of the 2019 calendar year.
