Sewage Spill on February 10, 2022

HINESVILLE, Ga. (February 11, 2022) – The City of Hinesville Public Works / ESG Operations, Inc. reported a sewage spill of 37,500 gallons of wastewater on at 801 West Oglethorpe Hwy on Thursday, February 10.

The cause of the spill was a blocked sewer line that leaked into the unnamed tributary of Peacock Creek.

The area has been cleaned and limed and the blockage has been removed. Additionally, the EPD and health department have been notified.
