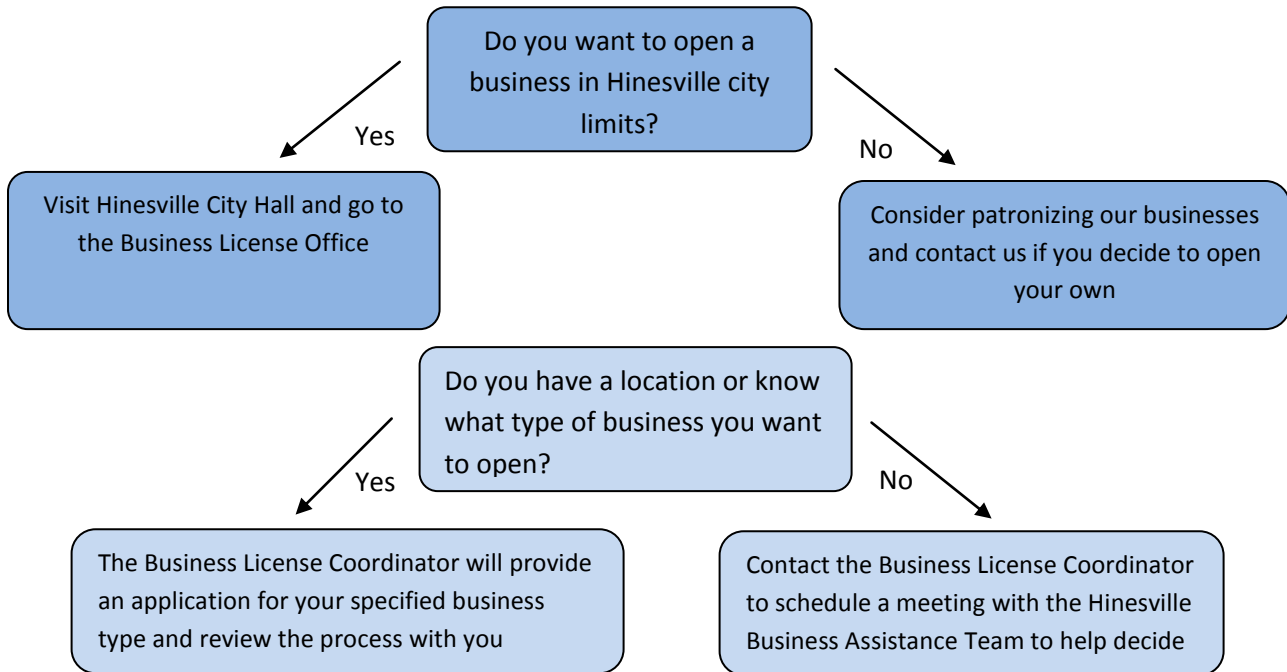


How to Open a Business in Hinesville, Georgia
